Declaration 2

Shatt Al-Arab University College is working to consolidate the principles of equality in various matters, starting with appointments of teachers and staff, ending with determining students and preparing the variety of book references, teaching and logistical requirements.

The 2005 Constitution of the Republic of Iraq stipulates the principle of equality and non-discrimination in terms, Article 14 states that Iraqis are equal before the law without discrimination based on gender, race, nationalism, origin, color, religion, sect, belief, opinion, or economic or social status. These are general guidelines that Shatt Al-Arab University College adheres to and does not deviate from, and this commitment comes from believing in and trusting to follow them as they chart a way of life and an approach to progress and development.

Shatt Al-Arab University College is a legal entity that supports pluralism and civil peace, seeks to revive the spirit of citizenship among students and, through them, in the community of Basra city, by implementation of the university's duties towards society in general and academics in particular, which contributes to maintaining stability and the desired social, cultural and economic development.

In all above commitments, Shatt Al-Arab University College also believes with Universal Declaration of Human Rights, particularly article 1 that states, "All human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights". And article 2 which states "Everyone is entitled to all the rights and freedoms set forth in this Declaration, without distinction of any kind, such as race, color, sex, language, religion, political or other opinion, national or social origin, property, birth or other status. Furthermore, no distinction shall be made on the basis of the political, jurisdictional or international status of the country or territory to which a person belongs, whether it be independent, trust, non-self-governing or under any other limitation of sovereignty".
